



Covidien quickly responded to the earthquake relief efforts by donating truckloads of medical supplies, devices and pharmaceuticals from across our product lines. Since Covidien's initial response to the earthquake in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, the Company has sent millions of dollars of product donations to provide care to people being treated in both Haiti and the Dominican Republic. The continuing medical needs of Haiti are being assessed and we are working alongside our corporate partners and others to ensure those needs are met.

Covidien's three long-standing partners - AmeriCares, Direct Relief International and MedShare - are managing our donations. Medical teams on the ground in Haiti and the Dominican Republic used our products in existing and temporary field hospitals as well as makeshift clinics. The teams are also supporting in-country partners which include: Boston-based Partners in Health (who operate a 104-bed hospital and 9 clinics in Haiti), St. Damien Children's Hospital, Haitian Health Foundation, Save the Children, MOSCHTA (a mobile medical van), and several others. Covidien also provided supplies to the USS Comfort hospital ship through Project HOPE.

Most recently, Covidien made a cash donation to Hôpital Albert Schweitzer Haiti (HAS). HAS is one of the very few hospitals that were able to treat complex injuries in their operating rooms immediately following the quake. They will continue to provide long-term care to those requiring additional complex procedures—surgery, high-risk obstetrics, and neonatal care for infants.
